

### Registration Report – 11-3-2009

- Over 3000 athletes registered to date
- 4 clubs have not registered yet
- Now billing clubs monthly – This is a much more accurate process
- 30 Coach registration applications not meeting certifications – I am sure they are still coaching – I hope that referees are checking lists/cards on deck
- Membership cards in individual envelopes with appropriate Bag Tag – packets being mailed to athlete reps to give out – USA Swimming wants each card in each athletes hand – this is how we are doing it!
- Bag tags being disseminated to all swimmers 9 and over: Q-Times tag for State Champs and the USA Time Standards for new swimmers only
- Due to more early registrations – meet recons have been pretty clean – only 2 \$100 fines to date and that is great!!

### Club Development Report – 11-3-2009

- 2 more months for clubs to achieve Level 1 – or above – HUUU was the most recent to achieve their Level 1 – we are #1 in the nation!!!!
- Emails sent out to all teams today as a reminder and as a collection process
- MD Swimming has achieved Level 1 – USA Swimming Leap Program – assignments given out to Board members with the idea of announcing at by State Champs Meet that we have achieved Level 2 – several things are already completed
- All documents must be constantly updated and approved – we can never let our governing documents fall into such disrepair again

- Working on ideas for 2010 Grant program – any suggestions are very welcome
- Plan for Grant program is to continue – pushing coach education – thru 2012 and then re-evaluate – in relation to USA requirements or plans as well as our own LSC plans and programs
