FACILITY

The competition pool at Loyola Blakefield has been certified in accordance with 104.2c(4) Pool: Loyola Blakefield is an 8 lane 25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane lines. Colorado Time System with a full matrix scoreboard and horn start. The Depth of the starting end is 12 feet. The aquatic center at Loyola uses the latest state of the art UV System for improved air and water quality. The pool depth is 12 feet at the starting end and 4 feet and ½ feet at the turning end.

Directions: I-695 Baltimore Beltway to exit 25 Charles Street. Drive approximately ¾ mile and make a left on Chestnut Ave. Turn left onto the main campus drive, drive past the football field on your right and drive past Knott Hall. Park in the lots both gravel and paved near Sheridan Hall and across from the practice fields. Enter the Facility through the double doors into the lobby area of the pool. DO NOT enter through the front of Knott Hall and DO NOT park on the access drive next to the pool. Pool is in the very rear of Knott Hall.

All areas of Loyola Blakefield are Off Limits except for the lobby area of the pool, the stands, the restrooms and pool locker rooms and the pool itself.

Shoes are only allowed on the deck for coaches/officials/workers

SAFETY	The MSI Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated.	
RACING STARTS	Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by an USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.	
RULES	<p>This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated. MD Swim rules shall also apply. Per Maryland Swimming rules, any club that registers an unregistered athlete will be subject to a \$100 fine per occurrence. Only registered swimmers, coaches, officials, and working meet personnel will be allowed on deck.</p> <p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</p> <p>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the starting blocks or in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. USA Swimming Rules Article 202.4.9(H, I, J) and 305.3 Code of Conduct.</p>	

ELIGIBILITY	<p>This meet is open to all swimmers 8 years or younger. This is a No Time Standard Meet.</p> <p>All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet.</p> <p>A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet.</p>
SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES	<p>Loyola Blakefield Aquatics welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Loyola Blakefield Aquatics ability to accommodate all requests.</p>
HEALTH GUIDELINES	<p>All meets in the Maryland Swimming LSC are guided by the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene as posted on the Maryland Swimming Website. This not only applies to Viral Gastroenteritis but other infectious diseases as well. The Meet Staff has the authority to inform and protect coaches and swimmers from a potential outbreak of illness. At the discretion of the Meet Referee, any participants or spectators who exhibited symptoms of illness within 24 hours prior and/or during the event may be asked to withdraw from the competition and/or leave the venue as a safety precaution.</p>

E-mailed entries should include a hy-tek file, an entry report by swimmer, and an entry fee report. Entries should also include sizes for a t-shirt for each swimmer. ENTRY LIMITATIONS	Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual per session
ENTRY VERIFICATION	An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

MEET MANAGEMENT	LBA, with the approval of the Technical Planning Chair, reserves the right to split or combine sessions in order to run an efficient meet. The order of events will not be adjusted when sessions are adjusted.
ENTRY DEADLINES	<p>The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. No late entries will be accepted. There will be no on deck registrations. Each team is requested to submit one check to cover entry fees. Entries will not be considered complete without a check and size totals for t-shirts for your team.</p> <p>Maryland LSC entries received prior to the entry deadline receive priority over out of LSC entries received.</p>

SEEDING	The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order		
SCRATCHES	There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block		
SCORING	No team or individual scoring will be kept.		
AWARDS	Each Swimmer will receive 1 t-shirt for their participation		
RESULTS	Results will be posted on MSI's website within 24 hours of the meet's conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-tek backups either on a memory stick or via email attachment.		
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of certification/ registration and shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches meetings.		

OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS	There will be a need for officials. LBA welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of certification/registration. Officials shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers.
HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS	There will be limited concessions. Programs will be available for a charge of \$5.00
WARM-UP	In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.
